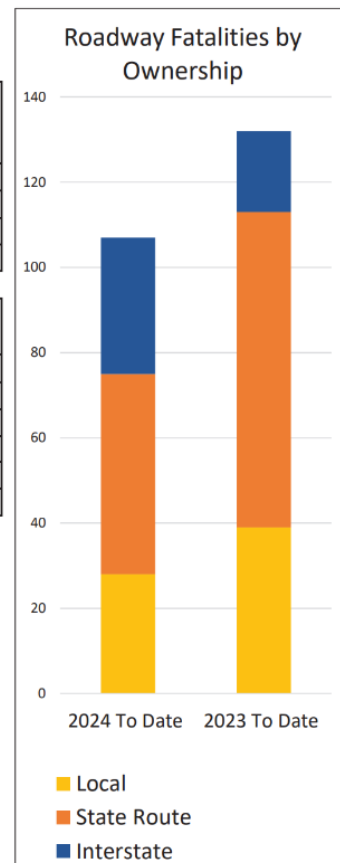

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6. Reports from Vision Zero Advisory Committee Members and Subcommittees

- **New Member Subcommittee**

Sam Warlick and Stephanie Owens have both accepted the nomination to join the committee and Austin Fernandez has not yet responded to the nomination

- **Outreach Subcommittee**

- a. There are ongoing questions about the VZAC marketing funding and how it is allocated
 - Ms. Martinez indicated that VZAC has 1 million in funding for specific Vision Zero education
- b. There is a need for more clarity regarding what is being shared about VZAC, how the language can be improved and how VZAC can be involved
- c. Ms. Martinez will share more information about the budget in the January 2025 meeting

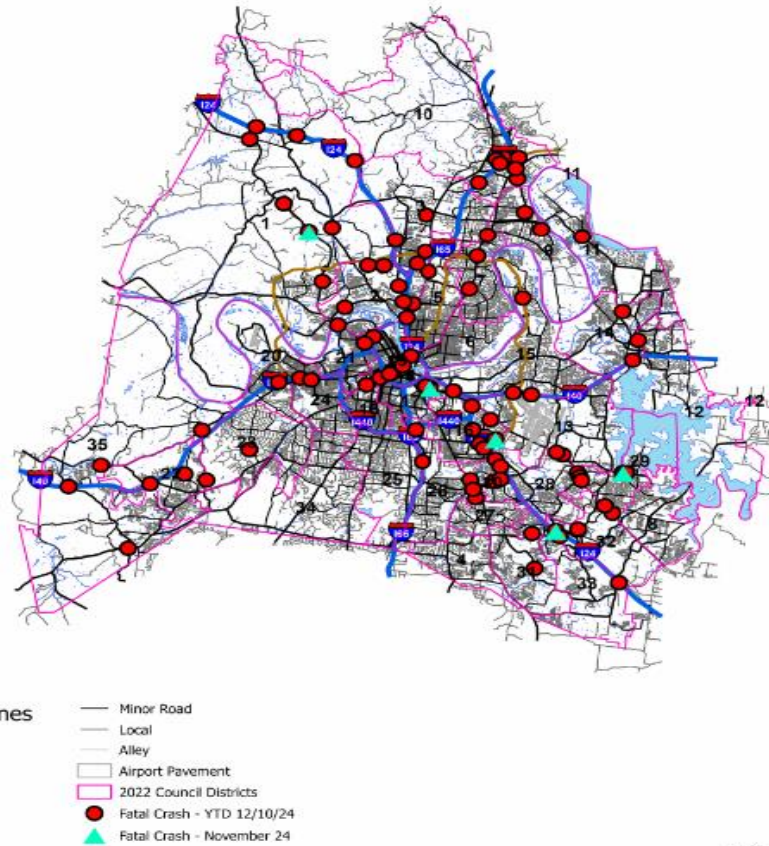
- **Planning and Engineering Subcommittee**

- a. Meeting on December 17th
- b. Discussed crash in Ewing on August 23rd. As a result, NDOT is planning traffic feedback signs and restriping as well as adding a crosswalk for the school at the Ewing/Gwynnwood crossing
- c. Plans are to look at crashes over the past year and make selections for follow-up within the next year



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- d. Get recommendations from fatal crash reports onto a map so the improvements can be tracked



- e. Questions regarding how studies get prioritized for funding, specifically Nolensville Pike
- f. Next meeting is scheduled for December 19, 2024

Vision Zero Budget History and Project Updates

2. Capital Spending Plan
3. 2024 Capital Dollars for NDOT are divided into different programs
 - a) NDOT submits project to Mayor including cost estimates



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- b) The Mayor's office will approve requests and fund at their discretion which may result in lower funding than requested
- 4. CIB is not constrained and is a "wishlist" from each department and councilmember
- 5. CSP is a list of what is actually funded
- 6. Capital Project Itemization Forms are available on the Metro website
- 7. Surplus funding is neither guaranteed nor consistent
- 8. Ms. Martinez reviewed a breakdown of VZ projects from 2022-2024 with their allocated funding, program status, KPIs, and the 5 E's each addresses
- 9. The committee would like to track what is allocated vs what is spent (perhaps in the quarterly budget meetings)
- 8. **New Discussion**
 - 1. Mr. Weingartner reported the speed on Lebanon Pike was increased to 40mph by NDOT from the initial recommendation to TPC of 35mph
 - 2. Mr. Renfro announced that LED street lighting has been installed and improved on Charlotte
 - 3. NashvilleStreetLights.com has a FAQ that helps defend LED installation
