

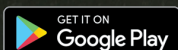
Businesses can benefit

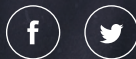

Those who have served our nation in the military deserve the full measure of our gratitude. That is why the Nashville Davidson County Register of Deeds offers the Thank a Veteran service to Veterans living in Nashville.

Veterans already are able to record their official DD214 military discharge papers with the Register of Deeds office. Now, the Register of Deeds provides them with a personal photo ID card to show as proof of service to Tennessee businesses that offer military discounts and other

No more carrying around or losing copies of their DD214s. No more missing out on a Veteran discount due to no proof of service. Instead, Veterans will have a convenient card they can present when they pay for goods and services at Veteran-friendly stores, restaurants, and other businesses.

Working hand-in-hand with Veterans organizations

Information is power, and the Register of Deeds office is working to get the word to every Veteran in Nashville who can benefit from the Thank a Veteran program. We are working with the many local groups that serve our military Veterans so that none of these heroes misses this valuable – and well deserved – benefit.

Simple and free of charge

Bring your DD214 discharge papers and a valid photo ID to our offices at 300 Deaderick Street, and a member of our experienced staff will file a permanent record of the DD214. If you have already had your DD214 recorded with us, just bring a valid photo ID.

While you are here, we will create the Thank a Veteran photo ID card that you can take with you. Of course, this service is free, as a way for Register of Deeds Karen Johnson and her staff to express their appreciation for your service.
