

BALL DIAMOND RESERVATION PROCEDURE

KEY DEPOSITS FOR USE OF LIGHTS, RESTROOMS, AND GATES ARE \$50.00 CASH ONLY PER KEY.

Reservations for ball diamonds begin the third Monday in March and close the last day of October each year.

There are three steps to reserving a ball diamond:

1. Making/paying for the reservation
2. Receiving the permit
3. Checking out keys if needed

We accept cash, checks, money orders and debit/credit cards.

Note: We charge a 2.3% transaction fee on all credit/debit cards transactions. This fee does not go to Metro but to a third party processor.

Reservations are taken Monday–Friday, 8:00 am-12:00 noon by phone only at 615-862-8405 or you may come into the office 8:00 am-4:00 pm. Due to the large number of calls we receive, please wait on hold for our first available assistant. We take calls on a first come, first served basis.

Have the following information ready when calling:

1. Park Preference
2. Day of Reservation
3. Time of Reservation
4. Contact Information
5. Method of Payment

You may reserve up to fourteen days in advance. The day you make your reservation counts as the first day. For example, if you call on Tuesday, you may reserve a ball diamond up through Monday, 14 days away.

We allow only two reservations per person, per call or visit.

PERMITS

Reserve and pay to receive a permit. Once payment is received permits will be EMAILED unless requested to be mailed, or, you may pick up in person Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

DAYTIME PERMIT FEES

Residents: \$20.00 **per diamond** per 2-hour period

(E.S. Rose Park Baseball - \$125.00 per 2-hour period / Softball \$50.00 per 2-hour period – GAMES ONLY)

Non-Residents: **\$24.00 per diamond** per 2-hour period

(E.S. Rose Park Baseball - \$150.00 per 2-hour period / Softball \$60.00 per 2-hour period – GAMES ONLY)

NIGHT TIME PERMIT FEES

Residents: **\$45.00 per diamond** per 2-hour period

(E.S. Rose Park Baseball - \$155.00 per 2-hour period/Softball \$75.00 per 2-hour period–GAMES ONLY)

Non-Residents: **\$54.00 per diamond** per 2-hour period

(E.S. Rose Park Baseball - \$185.00 per 2-hour period/Softball \$90.00 per 2-hour period–GAMES ONLY)

Light Key - **\$50.00 deposit** (CASH ONLY).

Deposits

We refund your key deposit if

- you return the keys to the Sports Office by 12:00 noon the next business day following the permit expiration
- your team or league complies with Park Board field and light rules

We do not refund your key deposit if

- you lose or duplicate keys
- you do not return the keys by 12:00 noon the next business day
- your team or league fails to turn off the lights more than twice during the year
- your team or league damages the lock or light box

The cost depends on the number of fields lit by the same light box for a two-hour period. You are responsible for inspecting the light box and lock immediately upon your arrival at the field. If the box is damaged or the lock is missing, you must file a report to the Parks Division (615-862-8411) or Sports Division (615-862-8424) by 12:00 noon the next day.

Inclement Weather Conditions:

The Sports Department will determine if rain or inclement weather has made the field(s) unplayable. Monday through Friday please call 615-862-8405 before 12:00 noon or 615-880-2233 after 12:00 noon to check on fields. If you cannot reach our office and field conditions become unplayable, it is the responsibility of the user to cancel play if fields are not playable. Failure to do so will result in the user being responsible financially to the Parks Department for costs necessary to repair the fields that are damaged.

Ball Diamonds are closed beginning November 1 through March 31 each year.
