Visit one of the Driver License Reinstatement Centers listed below to process your reinstatement in person.

PLEASE NOTE: Days and hours of operation for reinstatements vary by location. Before proceeding to a Reinstatement Center, be sure to review [Closure Advisories](#) for the latest updates.

IMPORTANT: It may be necessary to cease taking applicants prior to the closing time listed below in order to complete processing by the end of the business day. For example: Closing time for reinstatements may be listed as 4:30 p.m. but we may stop taking applicants at 2:45 p.m. in order to process applicants by 4:30 p.m.

REINSTATE MY DRIVER LICENSE

The Metropolitan Nashville and Davidson County Criminal Court Clerk will assist in obtaining the releases needed for the State of Tennessee, so that your driver license may be reinstated. Below is basic information on how you may start the process:

How do I reinstate my driver license?

Contact the [Tennessee Department of Safety](https://www.tn.gov/safety) at 1-866-903-7357 or online to obtain a detailed printout of what conditions are holding or preventing the clearance of your license.

Driver License Reinstatement Requirements:

(The website requires your driver license number and date of birth)

Print the Reinstatement Requirement list. The requirement list will provide information regarding the county, the charge, the ticket/case number or possibly a phone number. Each charge requires all conditions holding your driver license be resolved and the case is satisfied to receive a release. The release is required on each charge on the requirement list from the county in which the violation occurred. Please bring the printout when you visit the Criminal Court Clerk's office.

Once the cases are satisfied, the Criminal Court Clerk's Office will work with you to insure you have the releases on charges within our office that the Department of Safety requires in order to reinstate your license.
