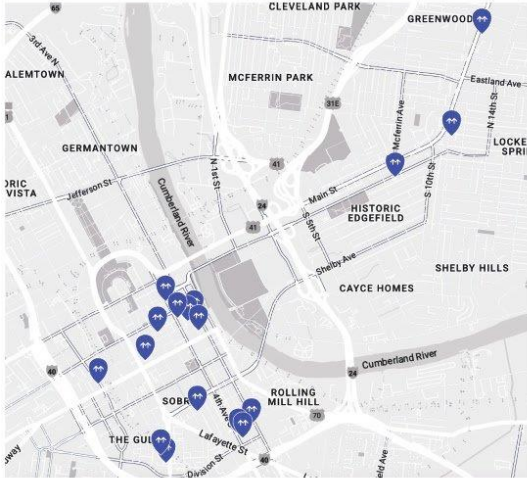
Metropolis' "Park and Play" program

The program, active as of August 15, 2025, provides free parking at over 20 select Metropolis parking lots around the city, aiming to support the local music scene. The result of a dedicated two-year effort made possible through the strong collaboration with our valued partners: Metropolis, the Musicians Union, and the Music Venue Alliance of Nashville (MVAN), and Councilman Kupin. Nashville musicians can get free parking through Metropolis' "Park and Play" program by being an active member of the Nashville Musicians Association (AFM Local 257) or by playing a gig at an independent venue partnered with the Music Venue Alliance Nashville, which provides a QR code for access.
